## Start Talking.

### ***Get the conversation started.***

- At family gatherings, who is the person that you can count on to discuss religion and politics? Do you join in the discussion?
- What does the term “religious” mean to you?

## Start thinking.

### ***Ask a question to get your group thinking.***

Do you allow “room” in your heart and mind for people that think and believe differently?  
What are the things that cause you to create distance from someone that’s not like you?

## Start Sharing.

### ***Ask a question to create openness.***

- Has there been a time in your life where you had preconceived ideas about someone, but when you got to know them, you realized you have a lot in common?
- What are the things that divide us as human beings? How can we break down those divisions inside the church?

## Start praying.

### ***Pray with your group members. Be bold and pray with power.***

Dear Lord, we know that you have created every human being in your image. Thank you that we are all different and created for a different purpose in your kingdom. Help us to recognize that every person has a place in your family and for us to accept others just as you have accepted us. Help us to open our hearts this week to new things, for your glory. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
